sav·a·LIFE Pregnancy Test Center was established in 1980 to address and assist with problems associated with sexual promiscuity, unplanned pregnancy and abortion on demand. sav·a·LIFE is the largest crisis pregnancy center in the Birmingham metropolitan area. We have helped save thousands of babies in our 36 years of serving Jefferson and Shelby counties in Alabama, by helping parents embrace the truth of God's word and make life-affirming decisions about their unborn children. Clients are welcomed in a loving, non-judgmental environment that represents a safe haven for many. Our comprehensive programs meet the health, emotional and spiritual needs of our clients by offering them access to free doctors, nurses, and trained peer counselors so that they are fully equipped to become better individuals, spouses and parents.

The demand for services continued in 2017. More than 9,500 client touches were made in all areas of programming. In the past 10 years, we have touched more than 65,000 clients through ALL programs and services.

LATOYA'S *story*

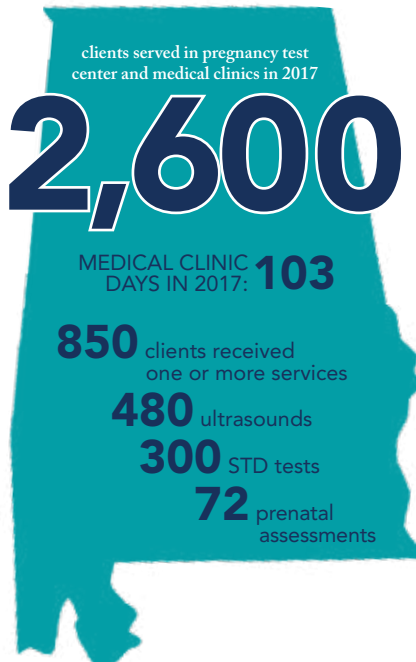

BY THE NUMBERS

pregnancy test center and medical clinics



sav·a·LIFE Pregnancy Test Center continues to see consistency in the number of individual clients served. Often clients return for additional assistance including prenatal assessment, STD testing, parenting classes, and much more thus providing our volunteers another opportunity to share the love of Christ. This year we will serve more than 2,600 clients in this area. More than 25,000 women and men have been served at this Center over the past ten years in this area of ministry. The Pregnancy Test Center is supported by many doctors, nurse practitioners, nurses, and other volunteers who selflessly give valuable time and resources to provide free medical clinics. Because of their generosity, we were able to host 103 medical clinic days during the past year where we served almost 850 clients through one of the more than 480 ultrasounds, 300 STD tests, or 72 prenatal assessments. For many clients, it's the only means to ensure a healthy beginning to their pregnancy.

FAMILY *education services*

One of the most consistent areas of growth at SAV·a·LIFE Pregnancy Test Center is in our family education services. We love this opportunity to encourage the more than 3,300 moms and dads who have visited this year to build a strong spiritual foundation for their family while they are learning strong parenting skills.

One of the most exciting growth areas within this department is the number of fathers participating in programs. Almost 800 fathers have been engaged through classes and programs in 2017. Involved and engaged fathers will lead to stronger families and children who have a greater chance for success.

Even though she and the father of her baby, Tevin, have been in a steady relationship for about 10 years, they were completely unprepared for the responsibilities of parenthood. Alexis began attending parenting classes to learn more about being a good mom. She earned the resources she knew she would need when the baby arrived. Eventually she would convince Tevin to join the fatherhood class where our fatherhood coordinator was able to challenge him to consider the next step in their relationship. Tevin accepted the challenge and asked Alexis to be his wife. Their marriage ceremony will take place early next year after they've completed marriage counseling. God used this ministry to help this sweet couple learn more about the covenant of marriage.

ministry goals

With God's guidance and your support our ministry goals for 2018 include:

- **Completion of education building renovation:** Ultimately, our desire is to do a complete renovation with additional updates to the entire facility. Additional renovations will cost approximately \$90,000. Our goal is to attain additional funding to complete the total renovations and not touch resources needed to better serve clients.
- **Family Education Services:** Once renovations are complete in our education facilities, we will be implementing an incentive program so moms and dads who participate in classes can earn larger ticket items like cribs or car seats in addition to the baby bucks they currently earn. Our education programs, where clients learn more about an abundant life for their families and themselves, continues to grow exponentially.
- **Begin updates to medical facilities:** Before medical services reach can be expanded, additional and updated medical clinic space is needed. Expanded and a more confidential reception area is also needed to better serve clients. Current facilities are at capacity. Additional medical staff will also be needed to accommodate clients.

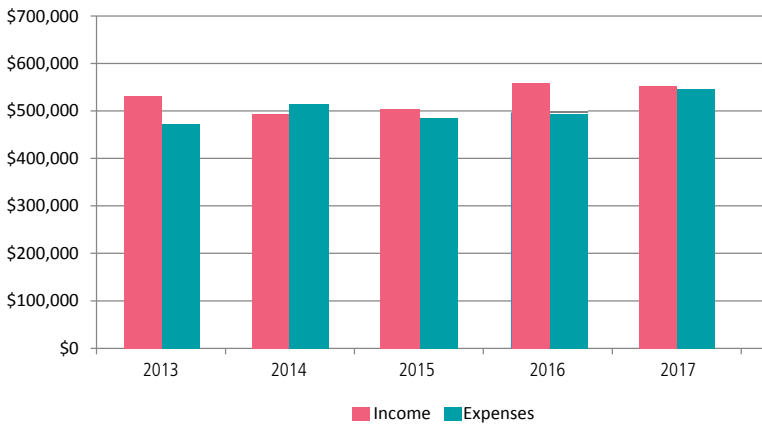
