
IMPACTING FAMILIES EVERYDAY

Sav· a·LIFe, Inc. relies on the service and commitment of volunteers to carry out our important work. We utilize volunteers in every aspect of our ministry needing at least 45 volunteers per week. Men and women serve regularly at our Crestwood, Vestavia and Fultondale service centers. We also need volunteers on a more flexible schedule to assist with special events and projects. Our volunteers need a heart to show Jesus' love to our clients.

SERVICE CENTER ROLES:

Once trained, volunteers in these roles will need to commit to at least one shift every other week with shifts lasting from 3 to 4 hours.

Client Advocates (male and female) provide medically accurate information, encouragement, and support to male and female clients facing an unplanned pregnancy or who need STD testing. Must have a desire to share the Gospel.

Spanish Speaking Translators are needed when Spanish speaking advocates are not available. This may be done in person, via FaceTime, or by cell phone.

Receptionists greet clients, set up intake documents and client files, schedule appointments, and route phone calls.

Medical Professionals such as doctors, nurse practitioners, nurses, lab technicians, sonographers, and medical assistants provide prenatal and STD care by appointment.

Mentors offer ongoing one-to-one education on parenting and relationship topics using an online curriculum.

Education Coaches lead group classes just for moms, just for dads, and for couples in our education programs. Classes meet weekly on an ongoing basis. Special topics are offered for a fixed number of sessions.

Fatherhood Leaders communicate to new dads the opportunity and responsibility of being a father. They use experience and education to guide and direct new dads in the spiritual, mental, and educational development for themselves and their families.

OTHER ROLES:

Baby Boutique Workers help clients shop, process and price donations, change out seasonal items, keep boutiques clean and organized. Boutique workers are asked to commit to at least one shift per week.

Class Sponsors provide meals for our evening classes, or co-host special events on a one-time or regular basis. Sponsors are also needed to provide snacks and water for ongoing classes.

Baby Shower Hosts, together with their Bible study or ministry groups, organize and sponsor a shower for graduates of our Gift of Birth class. Showers are held several times a year and include up to 10 moms, with their partner or support person.

Committee & Advisory Board Members assist the Board of Directors and Executive Staff with planning and hosting major events, fundraising, and community outreach.

Church Liaisons welcome clients into their churches for discipleship and community. They meet clients on their first visit, help them make positive, organic connections with other members, and follow up with them for ongoing support.

Prayer Team Members commit to pray regularly for abortion-minded and other clients to find us, clients to be receptive to God's Word, and for staff and volunteers to be protected from spiritual warfare. May also receive real-time updates and requests for immediate needs.

SPECIAL EVENTS

Volunteers are needed to help with a variety of roles for our major fundraising events, such as the Spring Celebration and Fall Golf Invitational. Hosts and helpers for occasional events like an Easter Egg Hunt and Family Trunk or Treat for client families.

Collection Drives: Organize drives to provide much needed items, such as diapers, wipes, bath items, onesies, pacifiers, etc. A list of current needs at each center can be provided on request.

Service Days: Our centers have ongoing list of needs and we always appreciate help getting caught up! Service opportunities include:

- Sorting clothing and diapers for the Baby **Boutique**
- Filling welcome baskets for new moms and dads (diapers, wipes, receiving blankets, bath items, devotional books, notes of encouragement).
- Groundskeeping mulching, pressure washing, weeding, Spring or Fall planting, trimming shrubs, etc.
- Building maintenance deep cleaning, building shelves, touch-up paining, etc.
